Requirements for new HIRLAMM website

- Easy uploading of documents
- Easy to write and submit articles by different people
- Authors are not bothered with layout
- Different ways in accessing articles and documentation, not only through content list of Newsletters. Use of database and search engine?
- Access to documents on other websites
- Automatic announcements for new information
- Easy maintenance
- Search engine





- Content Management System
- Large, active user community
- Many extensions (components and plugins) available, also under GPL license
- User can focus on content by using existing templates

- Everyone can help keeping the website upto-date




Website setup
